Handwriting Competition Winners:

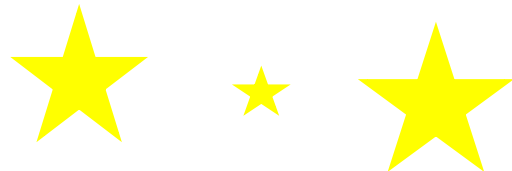
Handwriting and presentation has been a big focus across the whole school and this was very clear in the entries to our handwriting competition. It was a very tough one to judge! The winners are as follows:
