# Reading books

Reading books will be changed by the children but monitored by an adult.

- Ideally the children should be reading at home as often as possible
- How can you help? Emphasis on questioning about the texts.

# Homework

Homework will be given on a **Thursday** and be expected in by the following **Tuesday**.

- Homework will be related to the children's current class work and will consist of maths and spellings weekly.
- Reading 20 minutes a day
- Projects over half terms
- We encourage helping your child with any homework tasks, but remember we want to see the children applying their learning at home as independently as possible.

# How can you help?

- Encourage your children to discuss their learning.
- Read a variety of texts to and with your children – not just school books.
- Ensure homework is completed but encourage independence.
- Continue to practise areas of difficulty that your child may be experiencing.
- Make each learning experience as enjoyable as possible.
- If you have a question please talk to me and I will work in partnership with you to support your child's learning.
