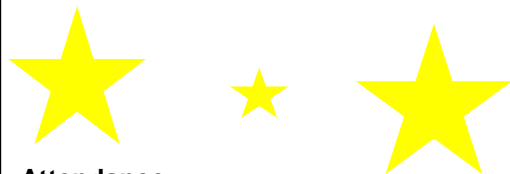

PE:

All schools receive funding for sports provision from the Sports Premium grant to develop the PE and sports activities that we offer. Through this grant, we now receive specialist PE teaching from Mr Berry who is a PE teacher at St. Mary's College. Mr Berry delivers lessons in school on a Tuesday morning and on Wednesday and Thursday afternoons. Mr Berry will work with each KS1 and KS2 class at least once during the school year and will also deliver some lessons to the F2 children in the summer term.

In order for the children to be able to participate fully in PE lessons, they must have the correct kit in school every day. The school PE kit is as follows:

- Black shorts for indoors
- Black jogging pants for outdoor use
- White school T shirt with school logo/plain white T shirt
- Black sandshoes (indoors) trainers (outdoors)

All earrings must be removed prior to the PE lesson for health and safety reasons.
