I hope that you all have a safe, happy and restful summer holidays and look forward to welcoming the children back to school in September.

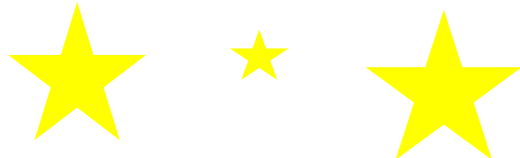
