Moving into Key stage 2

- Children are expected to be more independent and responsible for their actions.
- At the end of the school day the children do not have to wait with a teacher until they can see their adult
- There is no fruit provided at morning break – children can bring their own fruit

- Homework will be related to the children's current class work and will consist of maths, English/ SPAG and spellings.
- We encourage helping your child with any homework tasks, but remember we want to see the children applying their learning at home as independently as possible.

How can you help?

- Encourage your children to discuss their learning.
- Read a variety of texts to and with your children – not just school books.
- Ensure homework is completed but encourage independence.
- Continue to practise areas of difficulty that your child may be experiencing.
- Make each learning experience as enjoyable as possible.
- If you have a question please talk to me and I will work in partnership with you to support your child's learning.
