Dear Parents and Carers,

Happy New Year! I hope that you had a peaceful Christmas holiday with your family. We have had a great start to the new term and have a couple of new additions to our staff team. Mrs Stapleton is our new teacher in Class 6 and Mrs Donkin will be teaching in Class 3 each Friday.

Class 5/6 led our first Come and Pray liturgy of the term and it was lovely to welcome parents and family members to it. All our Come and Pray liturgies are planned and led by the children. Please see the diary dates for further details.

This week we introduced playground zones to the children. This means that the children can only access certain parts of the playground during break and lunchtime according to their year group. We have also introduced a rota for the outdoor playground equipment so that the younger children can use it without the older children.
